Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition ⁽¹⁾ 07/31/21 \$181.8 billion

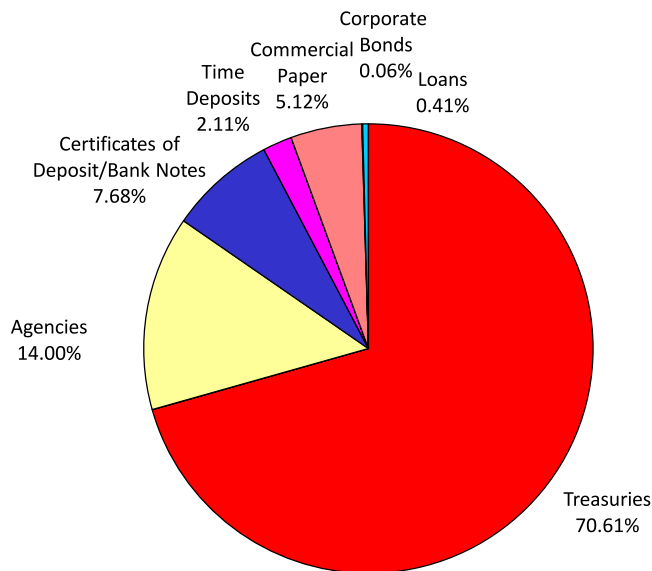
